Covid – 19 Restrictions and practices for Field Trials and Hunt Test

These protocols will be in effect from Sept 1, 2020 through Dec 30, 2020 to be adjusted as needed per any changes in state regulations.

For the safety of all, we ask that you stay at home if you have a fever or do not feel well.

Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow State, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is being held.

Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Ohio social distancing is 6 ft. Avoid congregating; no more than 10 people should be in a group. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others. No more than 10 people will be allowed in club house at any one time. Practice social distancing around horse water tanks. While riding in the gallery social distancing should also be practiced. Social distancing does not need to be practiced with members of the same household or family or people who traveled together.

Clubs will disinfect all surfaces in common use areas before and after the event and as frequently as possible during the event. Clubs must have plenty of hand sanitizer available for people to use. If porta-johns are used keep hand sanitizer/wipes available and if possible also have a hand washing station. At water tanks, clubs should have disinfecting sprays or wipes available to wipe down commonly handled valves and hoses. Where permitted, if ATV's are used they should be wiped down between users.

Clubs should keep a list of those who attend the event in case someone becomes ill after the event we can notify others. If someone does come down with COVID please notify the club holding the event, who will then notify the Association and the Association will notify the ODNR and any one else that needs to know.

Food - Participants should provide their own drinks and food. Clubs should avoid meals or employ staggered groups for lunches/dinners. Boxed lunches should be considered for judges and volunteers.

Parking – Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. Participants should wait by their vehicles/camp area until immediately prior to their running time.
