

GENERAL INFORMATION

Notice to Exhibitors & Handlers

- Car & van parking is **\$5 per day**. A weekend pass can be purchased on Thursday, Friday and Saturday for **\$12, \$10 and \$8** respectively.
- Overnight parking is **\$20** per night or **\$50** for the weekend. Tent camping is \$10.00 per night, \$30.00 for the weekend.
- Electricity is not available on the site nor are there sewer hook-ups.
- Quiet time - generators are to be shut off between 11:30 PM and 6:30 AM. Exceptions are at the discretion of the day's Show Chair.
- The All-Breed Grooming Shelter provided for Saturday & Sunday will not be available until 8:30 PM Friday.
- This is a self-clean-up weekend. You are required to take care of your business.
- No grooming tables, exercise pens or crates are permitted under the tents housing rings
- Smoking is not permitted under the tents housing the rings or the covered all-breed grooming area.
- The health, safety and life of any dog on the ground is paramount to other property and privacy rights. All vehicle owners on grounds waive their right to legal actions or damages should it be necessary to rescue dogs from the confines of an overheated vehicle.

DIRECTIONS

From Ohio Turnpike: Exit 135 (Baumhart Rd), then go South to Route 511, then West to the Show grounds.

From I-71 South: Take I-71 North past Ashland and Exit at Rt. 301. Take Rt. 301 North to Rt. 224. Go west on Rt. 224 to Rt. 58. Go north on Rt. 58 to Oberlin. In Oberlin pick-up Rt. 511, turn left and go west to show site.

From I-480 East: Take I-480 West of Rt. 10. Follow Rt. 10 and it will merge into Rt. 20 West. Exit from Rt. 20 West at Rt. 511. Follow Rt. 511 through Oberlin to show site (5 mi from city limits).

From I-90 East: Take I-90 West past Cleveland where it merges with Rt. 2. Follow Rt. 2 as it splits from I-90 in the Elyria area. Exit Rt. 2 in Amherst. Take Rt. 58 South from Amherst to Oberlin. In Oberlin pick-up Rt. 511, turn right and go west to show site.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

IMPORTANT - TRANSFER of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch 11. Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. TRANSFERS by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class MUST be made to the Show Secretary at Least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show, or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. SUBSTITUTIONS of Junior showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show.

No Practicing Allowed in Rings at Any Time Please, Pick Up Armband at Ringside

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judge Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

There will be no drilling, or intensive or corrective training of the dogs on the show grounds or premises
